- Services to aid and assist in the care of homeless dogs, cats and other animals
- Spay and neuter programs
- Educational programs on importance of humane treatment of animals

Grant Size

\$5,000 to \$15,000

Application Deadline

Proposals are due by noon on July 28, 2017. Please mail or hand-deliver **15 copies (unbound, paper clipped and 3-holed punched)** of the proposal to the Foundation offices, 500 Chestnut, Suite 1634. (Faxed proposals will not be accepted.)

The grant recipient will be announced no later than September 1, 2017.

Grant Restrictions

The grant will not fund endowments, deficit financing and debt retirement, or fundraising events.

Eligibility

Applicant must have an IRS 501 (c)(3) designation and provide services in Abilene, Texas.

Application Process

In narrative form, please describe the following:

- Brief history of the non-profit organization and its mission
- A description of all programs and services
- Identification of critical challenges or deficiencies
- Key areas in which grant funds are needed
- Measurable outcomes

Please attach:

- Cover Sheet (CFA form provided)*
 - List of salaried staff members and their positions
 - List of Board of Directors
 - Financial Report Form (CFA form provided)*
 - Project or Program Budget, if applicable (CFA form provided)*
 - Two or more bids, if applicable (CFA form provided)*
 - Balance Sheet (CFA form provided)*
 - Complete Financial Statement for the most recent fiscal year (if available, audited)
 - A copy of the IRS 501 (c) (3) tax determination letter
