

## APC Endowment Fund Grant

The APC Endowment grant is awarded to area non-profit organizations that are increasing access to mental health treatment for underserved populations. The grantmaking will focus on:

- Crisis intervention programs;
- Assistance for out-patient programs, including patient drug therapy needs;
- Programs serving military and dependents (retired and active duty);
- The committee will reserve the right to grant funds during special circumstances, specifically in the occurrence of a community-wide crisis event.

### Grant Size

\$5,000 to \$15,000

### Grant Restrictions

The grant will not fund capital projects, fund endowments, deficit financing and debt retirement, or fundraising events.

### Eligibility

Applicant must have an IRS 501 (c)(3) designation and provide services in Abilene, Texas.

### Application Process

The Foundation utilizes an online grants management system called Foundant GLM. All requested information must be submitted through this system, and applicant tutorials are available on the CFA website. Paper applications are not accepted for this grant cycle. ### Timeline and Notification

The grant application and all required documentation is due online by 11:59 p.m., July 30, 2021. Funding decisions will be communicated no later than September 1, 2021.

### Evaluation

The Community Foundation of Abilene requires nonprofit organizations to report on the impact of programs it funds. The evaluation includes details about the need the program attempted to meet, its objectives, elements, measurable outcomes, the role of partners, plans for the future, opportunities for improvement, and an accounting of expenditures. The online evaluation is generally required within 6 months of the grant's issuance, or prior to the next year's grant cycle. Organizations that do not submit program evaluations will be ineligible to apply for future grants.
